# Widicus Tied With Beltson On Net 73s

Peggy Widicus and Dory Beltson, who play out of Army Navy Country Club, each shot net 73 in brisk, chilly winds yesterday at Chevy Chase Club to share the first-round lead of the 36-hole Women's District Golf Association KEEFER Cup.

Widicus, of Annandale, last year's first-round leader, saved par with good chips and putts on her final three holes and registered 82-9—73.

Beltson, of Springfield, birdied the 17th hole with an excellent 4-iron approach shot and a 10-foot putt, and added six pars for her share of the lead with 83-10—73.

Sheila Dagucon of Montgomery was four strokes off the net lead with 80-3—77, followed by Sharon Briggs of Montgomery Village, with 83-5—78.

Widicus was a little more consistent than Beltson, making nine pars in the stiff breezes. "It's always nice to play well the first day," she said. "It's at least a two-club wind. Into the wind, I had to hit two more clubs than I normally would hit."

Beltson, who has lived in this area only two years, was topping some of her fairway wood shots but made four straight pars on the front nine and handled the wind well.

"I've played a lot of golf in Oklahoma and Kansas, so I ought to be used to the wind," she said.

The 80 by Dagucon was the day's best gross score (and put her in the race for the more coveted net prize). Next was Shawn McCullough of Woodlawn, gross 82. McCullough's handicap of 1 is the best in the field.

Defending champion Carol Davies-Lillie did not play. She is expecting a child in December.

# Widicus Wins Keefer Cup With Net 151

Peggy Widicus of Annandale and Army Navy Country Club emerged with the Keefer Cup yesterday at Chevy Chase Club after it looked as though nobody wanted the 58-year-old Women's District Golf Association trophy.

Widicus, the first-round leader last year who had a disappointing final round, appeared to fritter away her chances again with final-nine problems yesterday, but she instead scored a two-shot victory with a two-day net total of 151. She applied her nine handicap to a gross score of 87 yesterday.

Cami Berher of Montgomery Village, with a birdie and 10 pars, was second with net 74—153, followed by Son Hee Phillips of Army Navy, 82-72—154, and Esther Kemp of the host club, 81-73—154.

Widicus, who started the day tied for the lead with Army Navy club-mate Dory Beltson with net 73, appeared to be on an even keel after covering the front nine in 41.

But she took three double bogeys on the back nine, at which point she thought she had given the tournament away. However, she wasn't the only one who had back-nine troubles.

Beltson finished with net 82 to end at net 155, tied with former

winner Ellen McGowan of Springfield (net 74 yesterday), and Corene Turner of Westwood (75).

"I really struggled today," said Widicus, a member of Army Navy's strong squad that has won five WDGA team championships. "The back nine, I hacked it around. It's my first individual cup and it's really special. My friends helped me out today . . . It was nice going into it with a lead."

Widicus said she felt the championship slipping away when she made double bogey on the 15th hole en route to her back-nine 46. But playing partner Sharon Briggs and Sheila Dagucan, playing in the group behind her, both took triple-bogey 7s on that hole, perplexed by the severely sloping green.

Shawn McCullough of Woodlawn, whose one handicap was the best in the field, was the low gross winner with 80—162, followed by Dagucan at 85—165 and Briggs, 83—166.

Dagucon won the 13th hole with par to pull 4 down and had a chance to pull within three at the 14th, but again three-putted for bogey.

McCullough, who played on the Future's Tour in 1984 before regaining her amateur status, closed out Dagucon with par on the 15th.

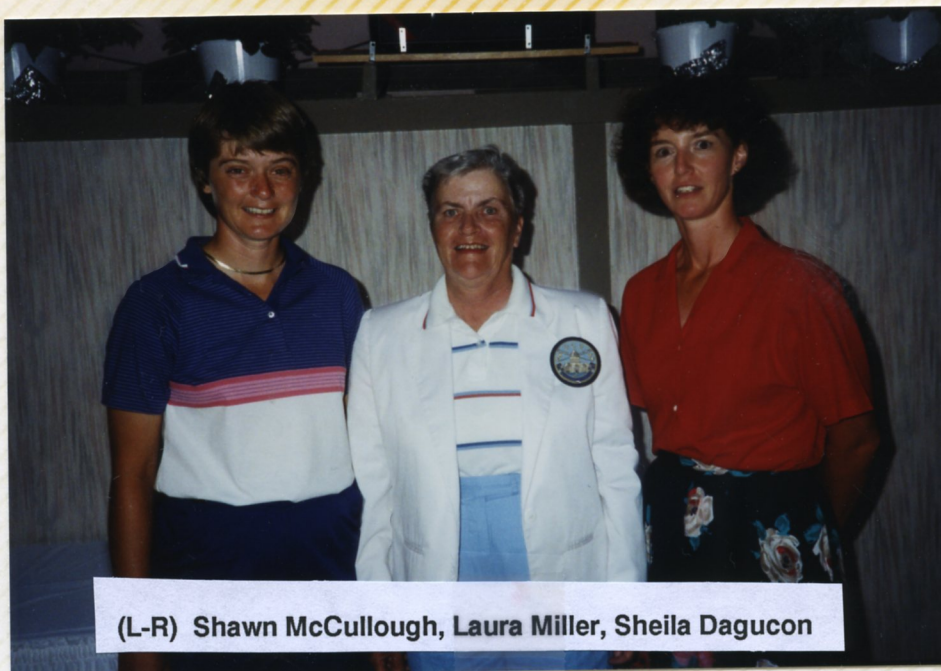

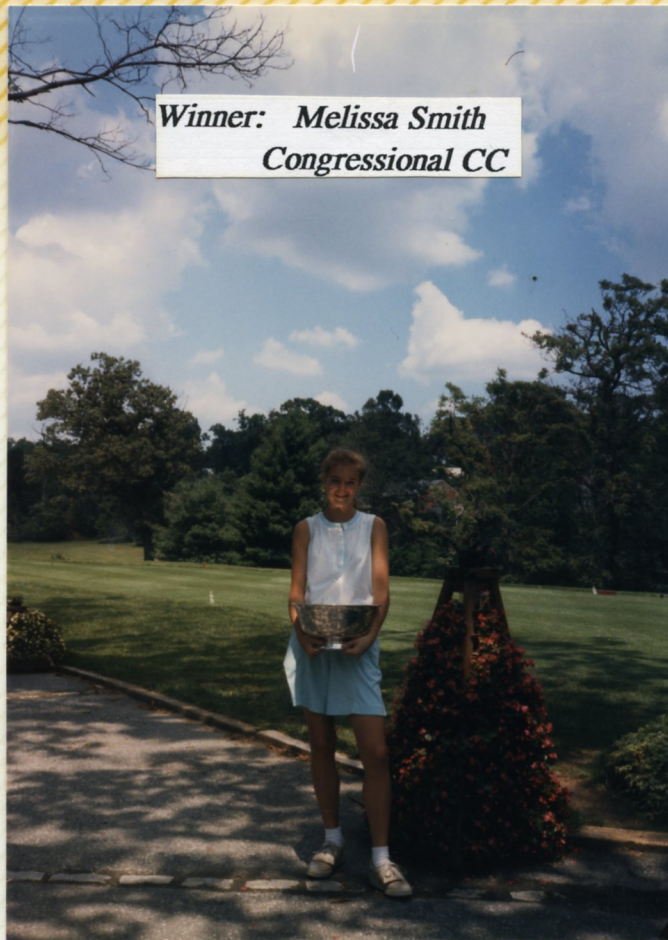

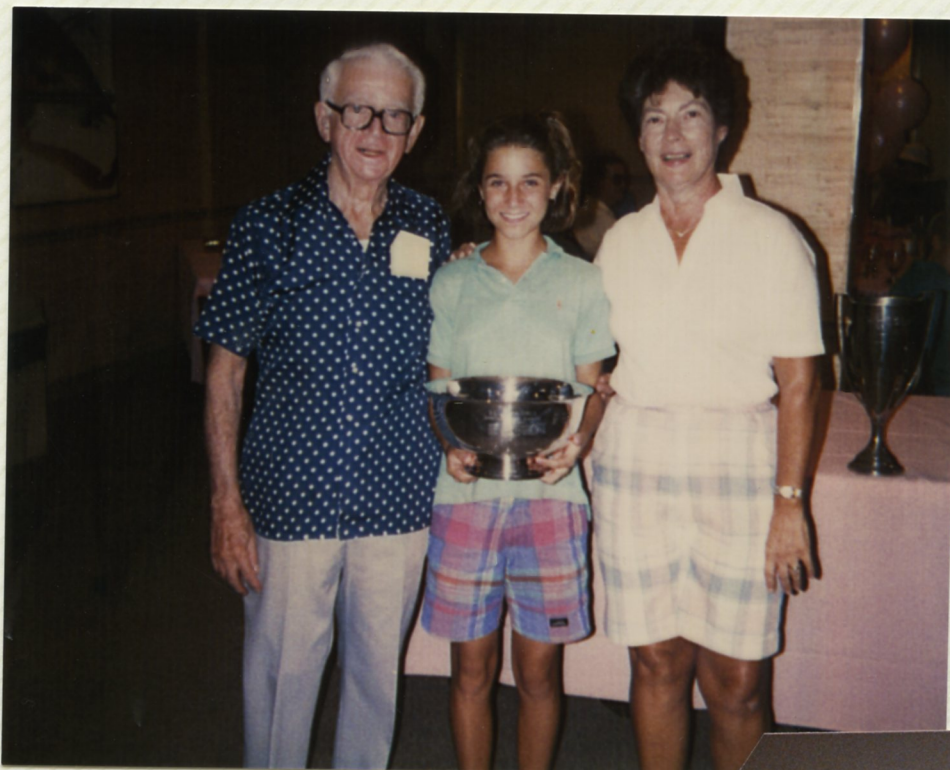

# No. 1 Seymour has eye on pros

After playing in the shadows of two taller and stronger women golfers for several years, petite Brenda Seymour (5 feet 3, 115 pounds) has fought her way to the top of *The Journal's* annual ranking of women amateur golfers for the 1987 season.

She has set a goal for this year of retaining the No. 1 ranking then moving on to the pro ranks in the fall.

"I want to give the pro tour a shot and see how I do," said the Hidden Creek Country Club member. "If I don't make it, I'll be happy being a teaching professional."

She will try to qualify late in the year for a card on the 1989 Ladies PGA Tour. If she fails she will probably join the teaching staff of Northern Virginia Golf Center in Clifton, Va., which is owned by her husband, Henry, a teaching pro.

In the four years she has been ranked, Seymour has been shadowed in 1984 and 1985 by 6-footer Kim Williams and in 1986 by 5-foot-10 Lois Ledbetter of Lakewood C.C.

The wiry Seymour may have a chance to test her game against the pros when the U.S. Women's Open is contested in Baltimore, July 21-24, and the following week by a regular ladies tour event at Bethesda C.C. Amateurs will have an opportunity to qualify for both events.

Seymour's principal achievement last year was winning the Middle Atlantic championship by four strokes and leading both days of the 36-hole event.

More exciting to the James Madison University graduate, however, was qualifying for the USGA's inaugural Women's Mid-Amateur championship at famed Southern Hills C.C. in Tulsa, Okla., and there taking former U.S. and British champion Carol Semple Thompson to the 18th green before losing, 1 up, in a second-round match.

The 28-year-old Seymour also qualified for the U.S. Women's Amateur at Barrington, R.I., but failed to make the 36-hole match-play cut.

She was a semifinalist in both the Virginia State Amateur, in which she was qualifying medalist, and the Women's District championship, in which she was beaten by the eventual winner, Ledbetter.

Seymour went to the second round of the North-South in Pinehurst, N.C., and was second in the Pepsi Invitational on the Eastern Shore. She was low woman amateur by seven strokes in the Templeton

Olds Classic program and posted the low gross score in the District Tournament of Champions.

Ranked No. 2 is Sarah Le Brun of Green Spring Valley, a senior All America at Duke, who won her second straight Maryland Amateur championship. She was medalist in qualifying for the U.S. Women's Amateur, where she was beaten 1 up by Carol Semple Thompson. LeBrun was also a semifinalist in the Western Amateur. Previous ranking: fourth in 1986.

In the No. 3 spot is Argyle's Karen Jones, former Maryland and District of Columbia champion, whose work responsibilities limited her competitive activity to only two major events.
