Malet Takes Keefer Cup on 1st Playoff Hole

Debbie Malet of Indian Spring defeated Martha Crosland of host Chevy Chase Club on the first hole of a sudden death playoff to win the Women's District Golf Association Keefer Cup yesterday.

Both 12 handicappers had 36-hole nets of 141, so it was on to par-4, 361-yard No. 1 for the playoff. Both were just short of the green in two strokes. Crosland skidded her pitch shot over the green and ended up with

double-bogey 6. Malet, who won with a bogey 5, said she tried in the playoff "to not think about everything around me. It was kind of surreal to me."

Malet was Wednesday's first-round leader with net 69 and shot 72 yesterday. She had two natural birdies on her final nine. On the par-3 13th hole she nailed a 7-wood tee shot into the wind and the ball stopped four feet from the hole. She made the putt for a 2. Crosland, who holed out her third shot over a creek on the 14th hole for birdie, closed with net 71.

Former Keefer winner Ellen

McGowan of Springfield was third at 72—142. Sheila Dagucon of Montgomery won low gross with 76—155.

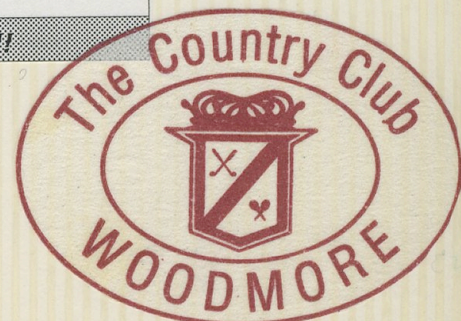

Briggs breaks the ice, scores first WDGA cup victory

Sharon Briggs of Montgomery Village recently claimed a prize that has eluded her for almost 20 years: She finally won a Women's District Golf Association tournament.

On July 16, Briggs defeated Lorraine Hou-lahan of Mount Vernon on the second playoff hole at the Country Club at Woodmore after they tied in gross at 78. As a result, Briggs was awarded the District's Class A Carpenter-Williams Cup.

One of the best parts of winning was that she got to take something home.

"I get to keep this nice trophy for a year," said Briggs, a highly accomplished five-time club champion who currently carries a 4.0 handicap index.

"I've won a lot of first grosses, but most of the cups go to the net winners," she said. "This is the first outright cup I've won."

The Carpenter-Williams tournament is one of the few District events in which the trophy goes to the leader in gross.

Among the local players who finished low in the net division were Lenore Martinez of Columbia, second net with 71, and Diane Herndon of Argyle, third net with 73.

Cindy Carlin of Montgomery Village, who later in the week went to the semifinals of the of Maryland State Women's Amateur Championship, earned eighth net with 75.

Rebecca Doman of Argyle shot 76 for ninth net and Deb Pearson of Indian Spring took 10th net with 77.

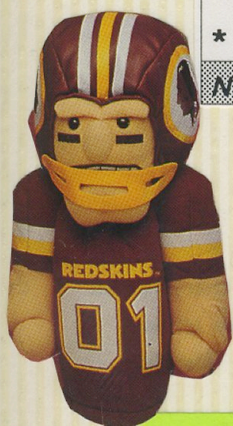

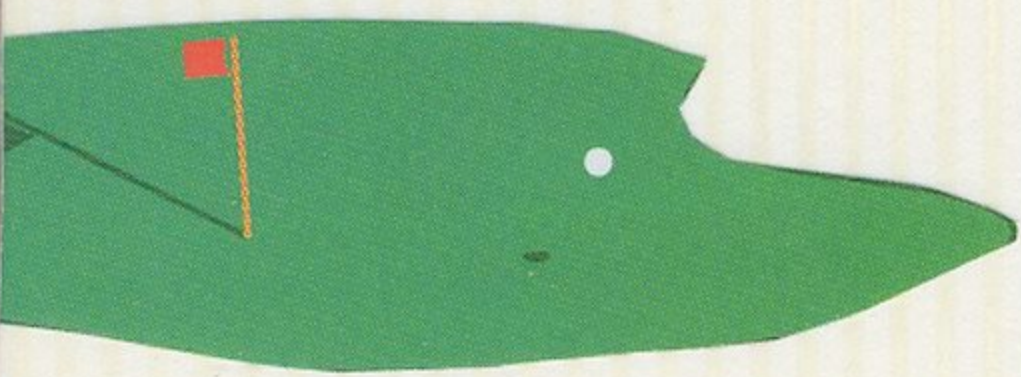

THE USGA introduced a simple, straightforward, and easy-to-remember procedure to adjust scores under Equitable Stroke Control that took effect on January 1. It replaces the old system that had been in place for the past 15 years and was not used properly by the majority of players.

The new way you are required to adjust your score sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's Course Handicap.

New Equitable Stroke Control

Course Handicap	Maximum Number Posted on Any Hole
9 or less	6
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 through 49	10
50 and above	11

For example, Uncle Snoopy and Woodstock played a match at Beagle Haven Country Club from the beagle tees. Uncle Snoopy's USGA Handicap Index of 11.6 translated into a Course Handicap of 13; the chart above reveals that he was allowed a maximum number of 7 on any hole, regardless of par, when posting his score for handicap purposes. Woodstock's USGA Handicap Index of 18.4 gave him a Course Handicap of 20; he was allowed a maximum number of 8 on any hole — whether a par 3, 4, or 5 — when posting his score.

Suppose one of these players picked up his ball after being out of a hole to speed up play? On the second hole, Woodstock picked up his ball two feet from the hole lying 5. His most likely score would have been 6. Woodstock jotted down an X-6; 6 is obviously less than 8, so he used 6 when posting for handicap purposes.

Both players had problems on the fourth hole. Woodstock made a 9, which

he then adjusted to an 8 for posting purposes; Uncle Snoopy recorded a 10, which he adjusted back to a 7 when he posted his score.

Woodstock made a 3 on the fifth hole. Uncle Snoopy was close to the hole in 3. Since he was out of the hole, he picked up his ball to speed up play. His most likely score would have been 4, so he wrote down X-4 but didn't adjust because 4 is less than 7.

At the seventh hole, Woodstock holed a 40-foot putt for a 7 while Uncle Snoopy was 30 feet from the hole lying 7. Since Uncle Snoopy was out of the hole, he picked up his ball to speed up play. His most likely score would have been 9, so he jotted down an X-9 and adjusted it to his maximum number of 7 as he was required to do for posting his score.

There is no limit to the number of holes on which you can reduce your score to your maximum number. Just scan your scorecard and locate any holes where your score (either actual or probable) exceeds the maximum number you are allowed. Then reduce those higher hole scores to your maximum number and post your total for handicap purposes.

When a player with an 18-hole Handicap Index plays only nine holes, his maximum number corresponds to his 18-hole Course Handicap. So, 7 is Uncle Snoopy's maximum number when he plays nine holes.

For Nine-Holers Only

For those players with nine-hole handicaps, don't despair. The new ESC

procedure can work for you, too! The following chart lists the maximum number those players with nine-hole handicaps may post on any hole they play.

Nine-Hole Course Handicap	Maximum Number on Any Hole
4 or less	6
5 through 9	7
10 through 14	8
15 through 19	9
20 through 24	10
25 and above	11

ESC is pretty simple, huh? Even a beagle like Uncle Snoopy finds it very easy to follow the new mandatory ESC, which speeds up play without altering most handicaps significantly. This new way to adjust scores replaces the old ESC procedure that was outlined on pages 10-12 of your Uncle Snoopy booklet. So keep this page handy and start using it today!

Remember, all you are required to do is find the maximum number you're allowed on any hole based on your Course Handicap. If you pick up on a hole, write down the score you most likely would have made. After your round, scan your scorecard for any hole where your score (actual or probable) is higher than your maximum number. Next, reduce these scores to your maximum number for handicap purposes. Post your adjusted score. That's all there is to understand about the new ESC procedure!

Mallory Crossland, WDGA Junior Champ, Surprises Herself

Mallory Crossland didn't expect to do well at the Women's District Golf Association Helen Goldstein Cup for junior girls. The day before, she shot 91 at the Middle Atlantic Junior Girls Championship at the Naval Academy in Annapolis.

But low expectations often lead to low scores. Crossland shot her career-best tournament round—a 77—at Indian Springs Country Club that day. And with that, she topped off an outstanding summer. She won the WDGA Cup at Army Navy Country Club, finished second at the Maryland State Junior Girls Championship, and advanced to the semifinals of the women's championship at the Chevy Chase Club.

What makes this summer even more impressive is that Mallory Crossland is just 14. But the National Cathedral School sophomore has always been precocious when it comes to golf. She began playing at five when her parents gave her a set of plastic clubs. She has been playing tournament golf since she was 10, and winning since she was 11. Crossland won the nine-hole division of the Goldstein Cup with a 47 three years

ago and has now won the 18-hole division two years in a row. Sometimes Crossland manages to surprise herself. That was the case at Indian Springs, Crossland wasn't sure exactly what her score was. She only knew she was one stroke ahead of Julie W. of Hidden Creek, the eventual runner-up.

"I didn't really figure out what my score was while I was playing," Crossland says. "When we finished, the girl I was playing with said, 'Oh my God! You shot a 77.' I knew I was playing well, but I didn't know it was that good."

She made a birdie on the 10th hole and hit every green except the eighth in regulation. "My problem was, on five or six of the greens I three-putted," she says.

Eventually, Crossland would like to become good enough to play for a college golf team. With three years to work toward that goal, she has to be considered a top prospect.

Other finishers in the Goldstein Cup included Chrissy Arriola of Bretton Woods, who placed third with an 89. Stacey Pusin and Jennifer Just, both of Suburban Country Club, shot 91 and 94, respectively, to finish fourth and fifth. Cassie T. of Hidden Creek won the 9-hole division with a 53.
