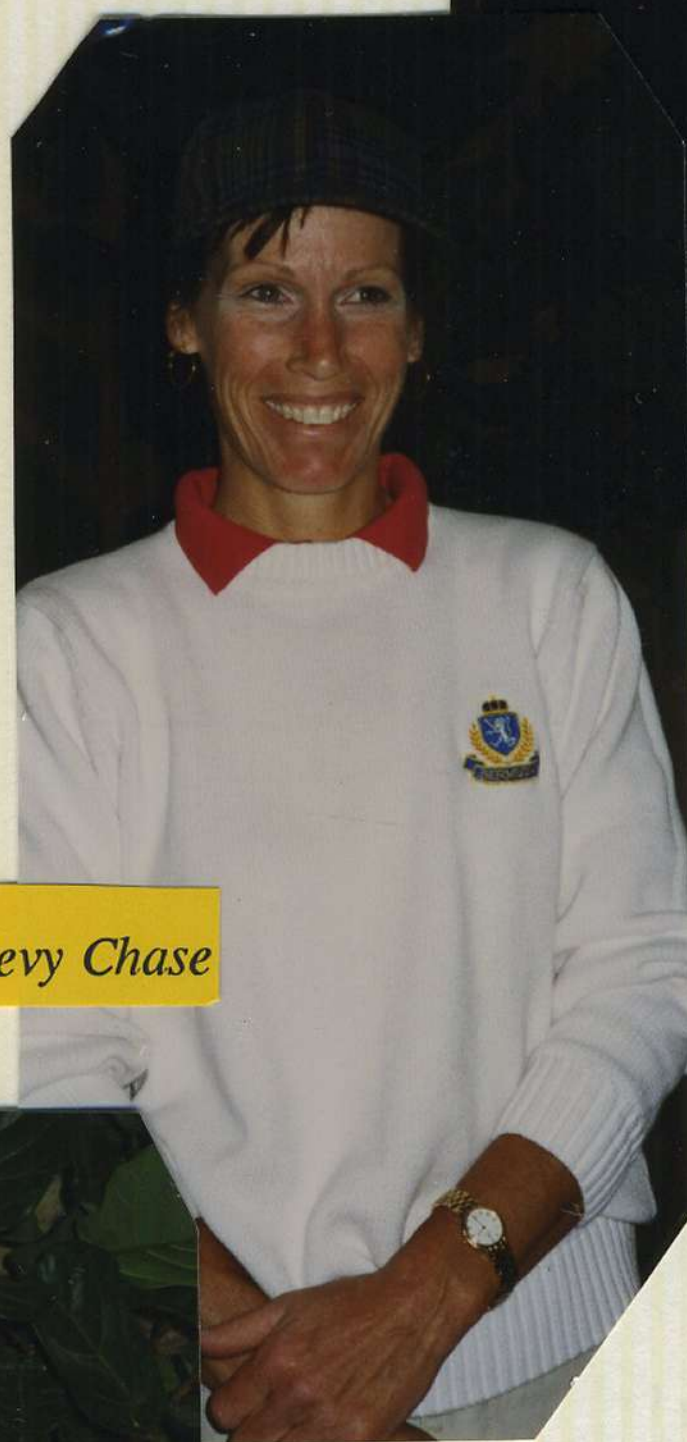

Keefer Cup Again Goes To Fairley

*Net 144 Beats
Verell by Four*

Paula Fairley of Great Falls struggled early but settled down over her final 10 holes to win her third Women's District Golf Association Keefer Cup yesterday at Chevy Chase Club.

First-round leader Fairley said she thought she had lost out after taking a triple-bogey eight on No. 8, but she made six pars after that and finished with 87-13—74 for a two-day net total of 144 to beat Belle Haven's Ruth Ann Verell by four strokes.

Verell, two-time Virginia State seniors champion, finished with 73—148, followed by Sandra Schiavone of Hidden Creek, 74—150, and Malsun Lee of Indian Spring, 76—151.

Former WDGA champion Sheila Dagucan of Montgomery Village made three birdies and easily won the gross division, adding 75 to an opening-day 79 for 154, followed by Pressie Hoffman of the host club, 80—165.

Fairley, who plays out of River Bend Country Club, was shaky on her opening holes. On the par-5 eighth, she hit a her third shot, a short-iron approach, short of the green, then chipped too strongly and ended up three-putting for a triple-bogey eight.

But after she made a par on the following hole, she said, "Maybe it's not totally over."

She settled down and made five pars for a final-nine 41 in registering her third victory in this event that was first contested in 1930.

"It was very exhausting. Trying to maintain your concentration for two days is difficult," said Fairley, whose family moved here from Connecticut in 1990.

Dagucan could not make a run at the net leaders because she carried the lowest handicap in the field (1). The Montgomery Village golfer was even par over her final nine holes.

Winner Paula Fairley fought through the cold rain on net 70 that gave her the lead in the Women's District Golf Association's Keefer Cup yesterday at Chevy Chase

who lives in Great Falls out of River Bend Country Club finished with a triple bogey by a slippery grip, gross 83; her 13 handicap

Keefer winner Ellen was second with 83-9— into today's finale. Ruth (85-10—75), Carmen (5-10—75), Malsun Lee) and Wanda Smythe

(81-6—75) were tied for third in the tournament, which will conclude today.

"That was yucky," said Fairley of the conditions. "I just tried to hang in there and not make stupid errors."

She opened with par-par-bogey-birdie, added a birdie and was doing nicely until the final hole. There, she could barely hold her club and pushed her drive to the right and ended up taking 7.

Let no one say that WDGA members are faint-hearted; soaked golf gloves, chattering teeth and rain-stained scorecards were the order of the day.

"It was pretty miserable out there," said Sheila Dagucan of Montgomery Village, a former WDGA champion who leads the

gross division with 79. "I've seen better days."

"It was nasty and miserable, but that's our job, to play through it," said Chevy Chase's Bailey Scheffer, who shot net 79.

"Everything got better once we got a windshield on our cart after nine holes. I can't play in any conditions worse than this—unless it snowed."

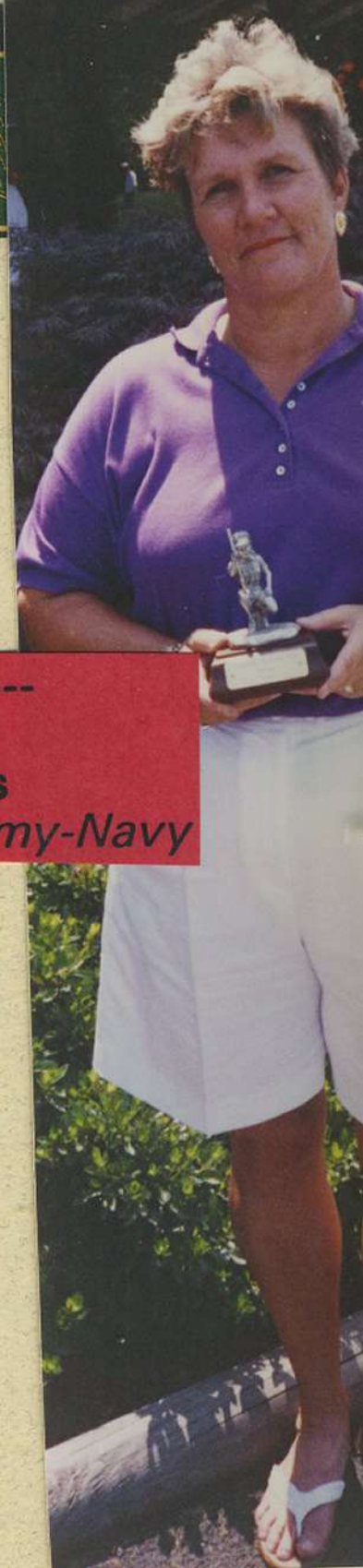

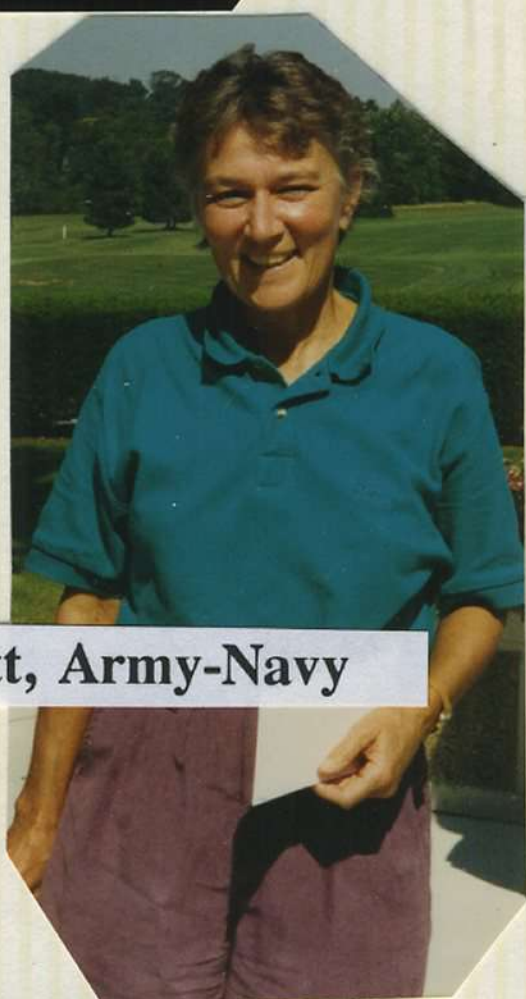

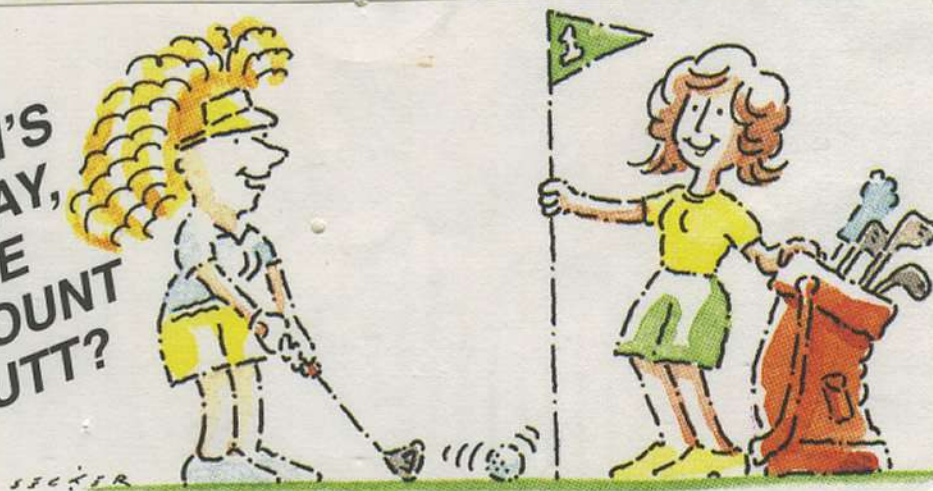

Woodmont's Lewis Rallies, Wins WDGA Championship

Jennifer Lewis of Rockville played superbly down the stretch and overcame a two-hole deficit to edge Ruth Ann Verell of Alexandria, 1-up, and win the Women's District Golf Association Championship yesterday at Manor.

Lewis, 31, who has played in this event only twice and has reduced her handicap from 20 to four in seven years at the game, became the first winner ever from Rockville's Woodmont Country Club.

It was a roller coaster for Lewis, who won the first three holes and then saw her putter go sour. She fell 1-down on the 10th hole when she skulled a wedge shot over the green from greenside sand.

Lewis looked like just another victim of cagey two-time Virginia Seniors champion Verell when she dumped her tee shot into the lake guarding the 11th green and fell 2-down. But Lewis played the next

six holes in 1 under par and owned a one-hole lead heading to the 18th hole. Both made bogey there, which left the drained Lewis with a narrow victory.

"I tend to play a little better when I'm down," said Lewis, who awakened at 4:30 a.m. and went to work as a computer marketer in McLean before every match this week.

It was a far cry from her first appearance in this event as a 20-handicapper in 1987. "I've been working hard," said Lewis, who fills her weekends with golf and has improved dramatically under the tutelage of Woodmont teaching pro Lyle Williams.

Verell, of Belle Haven, has won many WDGA events but not this one. She eliminated medalist and 1-handicapper Sheila Dagucon in the second round and had Lewis on the ropes. "I've got the experience. When I had her down two, I figure I'm okay," said Verell, who pointed to a missed short birdie putt on the par-16th hole as key.

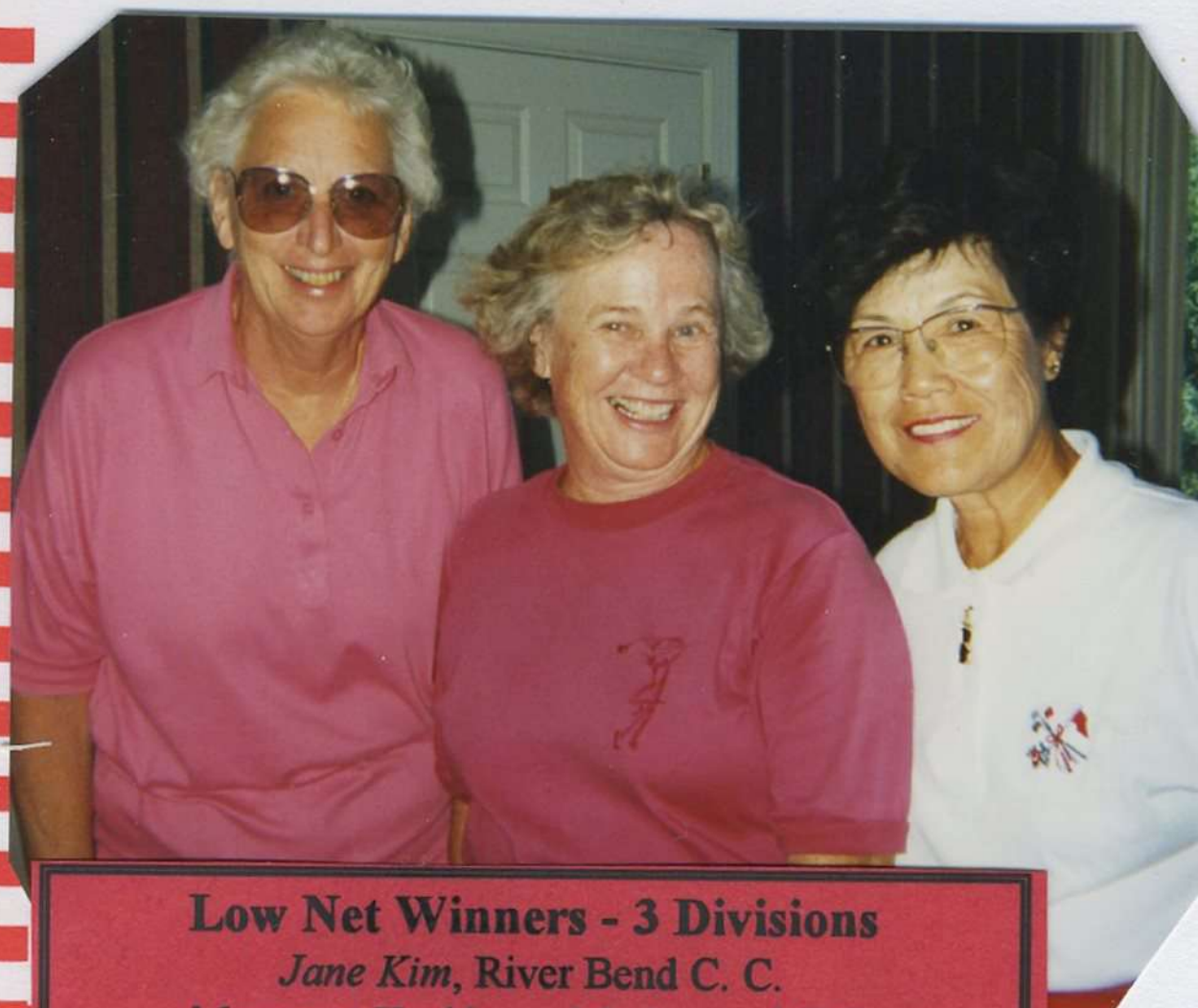

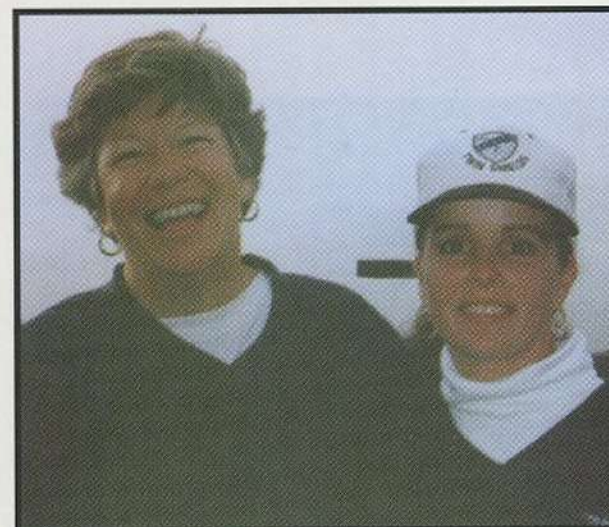

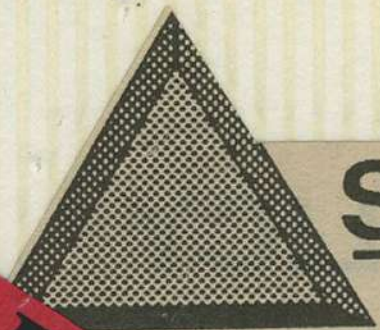

**MULTIPLE
SCLEROSIS
TOURNAMENT
DRAWS GOLFERS
TO A GOOD CAUSE**

Thirty-eight years ago **Jeane Ilch Hofheimer** won the women's golf championship at **Woodmont Country Club** in Rockville. What the sure-shooting 11-handicapper didn't know at the time was that she already had multiple sclerosis, a progressively degenerative disease of the central nervous system that has no known cause and no known cure.

"The doctors didn't believe in telling you what was wrong with you in those days," Mrs. Hofheimer said. Although her MS had been diagnosed in 1954, she wasn't informed about it until 1967, when the symptoms became so severe that she was sent to the world-renowned Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. "That's when I found out," she said.

Never one to bow to adversity, Mrs. Hofheimer in typical fashion turned her personal tragedy into an enormous opportunity to do good. In 1974, she started the **Jeane Hofheimer Multiple Sclerosis Tournament**, held annually at Woodmont on the first Friday of October, to raise funds for the National Capital Chapter of the Multiple Sclerosis Society. In this, its twentieth year, the tournament raised over \$23,000.

The MS Tournament differs

from most other fund-raisers in that, rather than being a one-day event, it is a process that continues all golf season, with women at clubs and courses throughout the area competing for spots at the final at Woodmont. As a result, the final field contains some of the best golfers in the region.

This year's final on October 7 brought together 106 golfers from 45 different clubs and courses in Maryland, Virginia and the District of Columbia. Top honors went to **Pat Kaufman** of Port America Country Club, low net with 71; **Cindy Carlin** of Montgomery Village Golf Club, low gross with 78; and **Kathy Oleson** of River Bend Country Club, low net for nine holes with 30.
