## Back on course,

# Vucich shoots for 2nd WDCGA championshi

Lakewood Country Club's Lois Ledbetter Vucich last played in the Women's District of Columbia Golf Association's Championship Tournament 10 years ago at Bretton Woods, where she won the title.

Yesterday Vucich survived the second round of match play in the 73rd WDCGA Championship Tournament at Indian Spring Country Club. Matches were played on The Chief, a 5,658-yard par 71 that is one of two courses at the Silver Spring club. Vucich, who returned to competitive golf this year after a six-year hiatus to raise her children, defeated Ruth Ann Verell, of Belle Haven (Va.), 3 holes up and 2 holes to play in the championship flight winner's bracket.

"I could have been better," said Vucich, who took time to practice on the putting green after her round yesterday. "I am not 100 percent pleased but in this game you never are."

Sixteen players in each of the five flights — eight in the winner's bracket, eight in the consolation bracket began second-round play in the double-elimination tournament yesterday.

Players in the championship flight were grouped and seeded according to Monday's qualifier. Players in the

four additional flights were grouped according to handicap index, then seeded by their qualifier scores.

Vucich is a Wootton High School graduate who competed on the Rockville school's boys golf team before county golf teams became coed. She also played at the University of Alabama and on the Future Tour, a professional "mini tour" for three years (1988-90). Then she retreated from golf to raise her children — Derek, 5; Christina, who will turn 4 next month; and twins Victoria and Bryant, 21 months.

"Now the golf course gets a part of me. ... I really missed the competition. I can't do 100 percent of either one. I'm trying to find a balance that keeps everyone happy. I can play golf and still be a good mom — they come first."

Vucich was the medalist Monday in the qualifying round, when she shot 2-over 73 and earned the No. 1 seed in the championship flight. It was the first time she'd played the course since she was a junior golfer. "I like the greens. They are very receptive to good shots," she said.

Verell kept her sense of humor intact despite losing to Vucich.

"I won a trip home," said Verell.

who will play in the Farmington Invitational in Charlottesville, Va., next week with good friend Lorraine Houlahan (Mount Vernon, Va.). Afterward, the two will travel to Calgary, Alberta, for the Canadian Seniors Tournament.

Houlahan was the Meta Streit Senior Medalist Monday after making a birdie on the first playoff hole against Verell. She won 1 up against Lanier Urbik (Army-Navy) yesterday in a championship flight consolation bracket match.

"I call her [Houlahan] one of the big girls — that means she's one of the best players," Urbik said. "It was fun, an honor to be in the championship flight."

Vucich will meet Linda Divall (Mount Vernon) in a third-round match today, at 8:30 a.m. Divall defeated Norbeck's Lisa Schlesinger yesterday, 2 and 1.

Divall's championship flight winner's bracket victory wasn't easy. She was 2 down after three holes and all square after the 10th hole. She won the 16th and 17th holes to advance.







## Crosland Women's Champ

Mallory Crosland finally collected something to show for a summer of high-level women's amateur tournament competition. Crosland, from the Chevy Chase Club, won two of the first three holes and rolled past Leland Beckel of Columbia 6 & 4 for the Women's Division 76th Amateur Championship at C.C. of Maryland. It capped a week of superior match play—the kind golfers seek but rarely find—for Crosland who was under par in each of her four matches.

The nineteen-year old Vanderbilt University junior had been on her way to the third or fourth flight after a front nine 42 in her qualifying round, but she bore down for an incoming 36 and a place in the championship. The final was a match between close friends, a pair of slender 5-foot-4 talents who are pupils of Bill Strausbaugh, the Columbia C.C. professional emeritus and teacher. It became a onesided game quickly, and when the finish came at 14, Crosland was 3 under-par and Beckel, a 31 year old mother of two, who had won only one hole, was 3 over-par. Crosland, who had split two matches with Beckel a year ago, had made the match play portions of the North-South, Western, and Trans National tournaments earlier in the summer but had not won a match.

With her home course undergoing renovations, the only practice Crosland had was at tournaments, but that work, combined with the match play experience against highly regarded players, provided the foundation for her title march. Crosland started with a first round win over former amateur champion Andrea Kraus 3 & 2. Another 3 & 2 victory over Rhonda Henderson from Fairway Hills brought Crosland to the semi-finals to face Jenny Chuasiriporn of Hunt Valley. Chuasiriporn, a twenty-one-year old first team All-American at Duke University, was fresh from her fine showing at the U.S.

Women's Open where she finished low amateur at 13 over-par. But this was to be Crosland's tournament a she rallied from three down through twelve holes to eliminate Chuasiriporn one-up. Crosland got a breal on the 17th when her tee shot caromed off a tree, missed a hazard and landed in the rough below the green. From there, she chipped close and one putted for par. Chuasiriporn found the right bunker and failed to get up and down.

At the 18th, Chuasiriporn had a restricted second shot, reached the green in three, and missed her par putt from twenty five feet. Crosland, hole-high in two, got a delicate down hill pitch shot to within six feet and Chuasiriporn conceded.

On the other side of the draw Beckel faced a stiff challenge from Connie Pifer of Hunt Valley. For her one-up win Beckel needed birdies on the 9th and 10th holes to defeat Pifer who was going around the course in even par. In the second round, Beckel defeated Kris Kefauver of Beaver Creek 4 & 3. The semis included yet another collegian
