In Memory of Sharon L. Briggs April 4, 1943 – January 21, 2002



Our dear friend, Sharon Briggs, died on January 21 at her home following a battle with lung cancer.

Sharon was a stalwart and respected supporter of women's golf. She was one of only twenty women across the state to serve on the Committee on Maryland Women's Golf, helping to spearhead efforts to gain a Women's Division in Maryland. She was also, for many years, right up until the time of her death, the Yearbook Editor for the Women's District.

Sharon had the heart of a champion. Among her many victories over the years, she recently counted the Women's District Senior Championship and the Maryland State Women's Senior Championship titles.

She also had the soul of a fighter. After her diagnosis, she never gave up her efforts to defeat her disease, attacking it with her unique brand of determination and courage. Her friends at Montgomery Village cared for her during her illness and their dedication to her says more than any words about the kind of person, and friend, that Sharon was.

As our Yearbook Editor she did us a great service by preserving our memories, year after year. Now we will do the same for her—remembering her always as an accomplished golfer, a grand companion, and an exemplary sportswoman.



THE SHARON L. BRIGGS AWARD FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE NOMINATION FORM

This award represents the highest honor conferred by the Women's District of Columbia Golf Association. Instituted in 2002 by the Women's District of Columbia Golf Association. The Briggs Award for Distinguished Service, is given periodically to an individual who has made an extraordinary contribution to the advancement of golf. Named for the late Sharon Briggs, a championship golfer from Montgomery Village Country Club, the award recognizes the attributes that Sharon exhibited so admirably throughout her life: selfless dedication to the betterment of the game, generous service to the golf community, appreciation for the ways in which the game can help others, and an exemplary sense of sportsmanship and fair play, both on and off the course.

Nominations should be submitted to the WDCGA Executive Committee [the officers], whose decision is final. Any man or woman, amateur or professional, is eligible for consideration. However, no member of the WDCGA Executive Committee may be nominated. The award will be presented at the Annual Luncheon in November.

THE SHARON BRIGGS AWARD FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE

Introductory remarks – November 14, 2002

Last year the Board was considering the creation of an award for distinguished service to be given to a person whose contributions to amateur golf had gone beyond the usual generous work that so many volunteers provide. While we were discussing the award, our dear friend and long-time member of the District, Sharon Briggs, died after a valiant battle with cancer. And, as we were reminiscing about Sharon, we began to realize that many of the attributes that we so admired in her were exactly the ones we wanted to recognize with our award. Of course Sharon was an accomplished golfer. In the years just prior to her death she won both the WDCGA Senior Women's Championship and the Maryland State Senior Women's title. But what was unusual was that Sharon was not only a great player, but a great worker as well, a combination that is actually quite rare. She was one of only 13 women in the entire state to serve on the Board of the Committee on Maryland Women's Golf, lending her prestige and support to the formation of the MSGA Women's Division. And she was, for many, many years, the Yearbook Editor for the WDCGA. Not only did she prepare our yearbooks every year – a job that, now that she is gone, we have realized is not easy – but she did it with her trademark generosity – not insisting on being asked each year, but always volunteering before we had to ask, saying, "Oh, I'll take care of that." And finally, there were the intangibles - her love of the game and of the many friends she had made through it, her belief in giving back to the game, and her unparalleled sportsmanship. And so it was that we found it particularly fitting to name our new award – The Sharon Briggs Award for Distinguished Service.

The award itself is a unique medallion. Cast from a die of the WDCGA seal, it is the only association medal that is authorized to be struck in silver. It is not contemplated to be an annual award. Instead, it will be presented only when there is an individual whose contributions to amateur golf have risen above the ordinary. The award honors the extraordinary effort. It is the highest award that our Association bestows and it is emblematic of the high esteem in which the recipient is held by the Association.

It gives me great pleasure to present the first award. Our recipient today is also a superb player of the game. This season she won her 20th club championship, becoming the first member of her club, Belle Haven, to win the title in each of five decades, starting in 1968. She is also a member of the Hall of Fame at Belle Haven. But playing ability is not what this award is about and I mention it only to emphasize this person's willingness to work hard not only to PLAY golf better, but to MAKE golf better.

She has been a leader in advancing the great cause of amateur golf for decades. In 1979 and 1980 she served as President of this association. Twenty years later, she was still every bit as active as she was elected president of the VSGA – WD in 1998 and again in 1999. She was a member of the USGA Regional Associations Committee from 1998-2001. Those are worthy

accomplishments and she could hardly have been blamed if she had decided simply to rest on her laurels. Instead she dedicated herself to becoming, as she has, one of the most respected golf rules officials in this region, scoring one of the highest test scores of any woman official. She served as the Rules Chairman for the WDCGA for the past two years and to our great benefit, will continue in that role next year. She is also the Rules Chairman for the VSGA – WD, and she will continue to hold that position in the coming season as well. In 2001 she once again responded to the call of the WDCGA and agreed to captain the Inter-City team – she will enter her third year of that captaincy in 2003. And, when the USGA asked the Women's District to oversee the selection of the first-ever USGA State Team from the District of Columbia, we once again turned to our uniquely qualified member....... And once again, she did not let us down, accepting the captaincy of that historic first team and accompanying her players to Minnesota to cheer them on.

On a professional level, she is a graduate of Allegheny College and is about to complete several years of service on the Board of Advisors of her alma mater. She holds a Ph.D. in chemistry from Columbia University. She currently is a coordinator for the Science Bowl, a nationally recognized competition.

And then there are the intangibles. Her sense of humor – a virtual requirement for a rules official, her love of the game, to which she has always given a 100% effort, whether as a player or as an administrator, and her rock-solid honesty.

So today, on behalf of the Women's District of Columbia Golf Association, for:
